## ★ KNOW YOUR RIGHTS:★ REGISTERING TO VOTE IN CONNECTICUT



The deadline to register to vote is November 1, 2016. You can register online, via mail, or in person with your local registrar of voters or town clerk. If registering by mail, your form needs to be postmarked by November 1. If registering in person, the deadline is 12 pm on November 1.



BUT if you miss the November 1 deadline, you can still register on Election Day. Election day registration is ONLY available in person at certain locations, which may not be the same as your local polling place. If you are registering in person, you'll need to show identification that includes your name and address. Examples of identification that you can use include: a Connecticut driver's license, a utility bill, or a checkbook. When registering by mail or online, you'll need to provide your Connecticut driver's license or the last four digits of your Social Security number.

You are eligible to vote in Connecticut if: you are a citizen of the United States and a resident of Connecticut; you are at least 17 years old and turning 18 by Election Day; you have completed confinement and parole if previously convicted of a felony.
